

# TNT guidelines

# **CONDUCT:**

- Fighting is not allowed
- Disobedience to persons in authority is not allowed
- Disrespect of any kind to anyone is not allowed
- Inappropriate physical contact (hand-holding, kissing, massaging, etc.) is not allowed
- Inappropriate language (this includes t-shirts, music, etc.) is not allowed
- Immodest clothing is not allowed
- Stealing of any kind is not allowed
- Lying is not allowed
- · Vandalism of any kind is not allowed
- · Pranks of any kind are not allowed

## **CABINS:**

- You may not enter anyone else's cabin unless permitted
- Never enter a cabin of the opposite sex
- You may not sleep anywhere but in your assigned bunk
- You may not use someone else's belongings without asking
- · Your bunk area and any shared space must be kept clean at all times
- You may not keep any open food or drinks in your cabin
- You are required to be in your cabin by curfew and stay there until morning

# **BOUNDARIES:**

- You are not permitted to leave camp property during the week unless approved by the Director
- Do not enter any area with livestock unless it is necessary for work and permitted by a Crew chief
- Do not enter any camp buildings without permission (craft shop, OTM, stores, Buffalo Lodge, etc.)
- Never use any camp multi-media equipment (sound systems, computers, projectors, etc.)
- The kitchen is off limits to anyone not working in the kitchen
- All camp vehicles, including Gators, are off limits at all times (unless you are approved to operate)
- Do not use any camp belongings (bikes, fishing poles, hammocks, etc.) without permission

## (TNT Guidelines, continued)

#### SUBSTANCES:

- Narcotics, tobacco and alcoholic products are not allowed
- All medication, including over the counter, must be turned in to the health staff during check-in
- Pornography of any kind is not allowed
- Weapons of any kind are not allowed (this includes knives that are not for work purposes)

## **VISITORS:**

- Personal visitors, including boyfriend/girlfriend, family and friends, are not allowed during the work week (unless the visit has been arranged with and approved by the Director)
- · All visitors must sign in at the ranch office
- No visitors will be permitted to stay overnight

## LAUNDRY:

- You are not permitted to use any of the camp washers or dryers for your personal laundry
- Camp washers and dryers may only be used for work laundry if approved by your crew chief
- Personal laundry should be done at home during your time off

## TIME OFF:

- You are not permitted to stay on ranch property during your time off (unless prior arrangements have been made with and approved by the Director)
- Before leaving the ranch, you must check out with your Crew Chief
- You are not permitted to leave with anyone other than a parent or legal guardian (unless prior arrangements have been made with and approved by the Director)

### **MISCELLANOUS:**

- You are required to be on time to all scheduled events (meetings, work, meals, activities, etc.)
- No electronics (including cell phones) are allowed
- Personal bicycles are not permitted on camp property
- All personal items (clothes, towels, shoes, etc.) must be kept in your cabin at your bunk area
