- Towels
- Toiletries
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Flashlight or Head Lamp
- Personal Safety Gear (skateboard helmet, sunscreen, bug spray, etc.)
- \$5-\$10 Spending Money (for offsite outings to ice cream shop, sno-ball stand, etc.)
- A Good Attitude and an Adventurous Spirit

## A few things NOT to bring with you:

- Electronics (cell phone, tablet, laptop, etc.)
- Weapons of Any Kind
- Immodest or/and Offensive Clothing
- Valuables (expensive clothes/jewelry, etc.)
- Anything Too Large to Fit Underneath Your Bunk
- Vaping Devices (vape pen, e-cigarette, MOD, Juul, etc.)
