Building For **The Future**

As we anticipate another 60 years of ministry, we recognize that our aging facilities have been stretched to their limits and require major repairs and updates. We must update our deteriorating facilities so we can continue this *life-changing ministry*.

To that end, River Valley Ranch is embarking on a two-phase, \$5 million Capital Campaign over the next six years to fund these renovations. Our immediate needs are outlined below:


